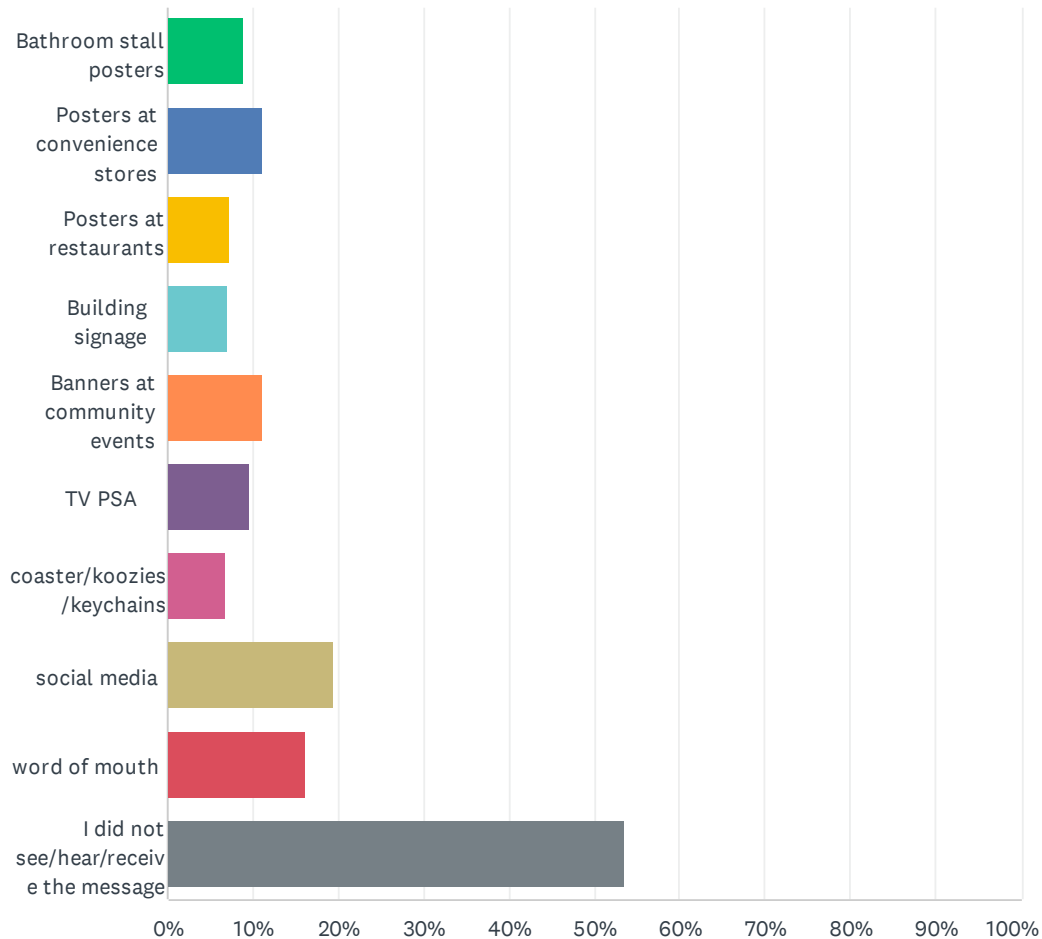

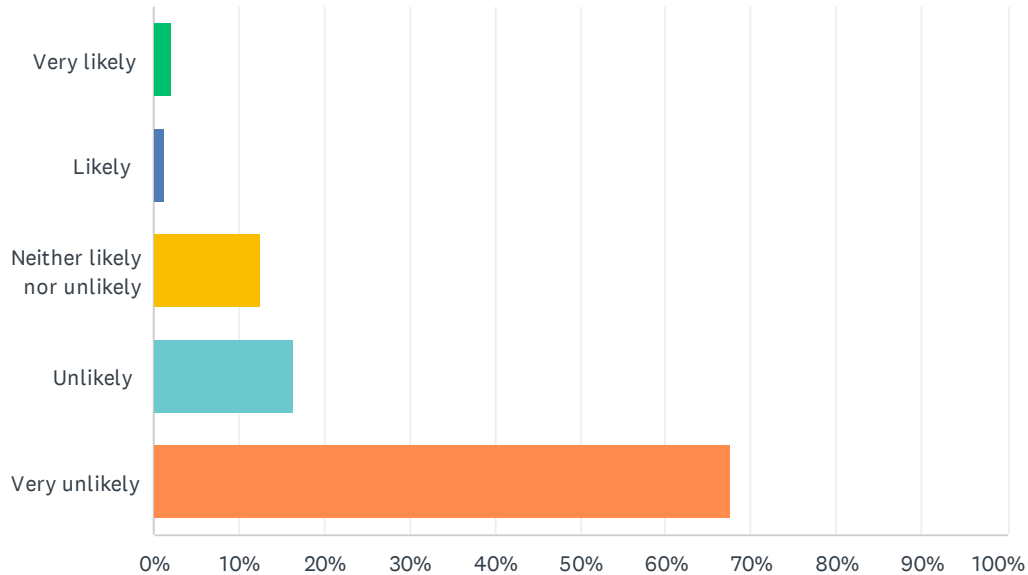

## Q2 How likely are you to drink & drive after seeing/hearing/receiving the message "Keep the Party Alive, Don't Drink and Drive"?

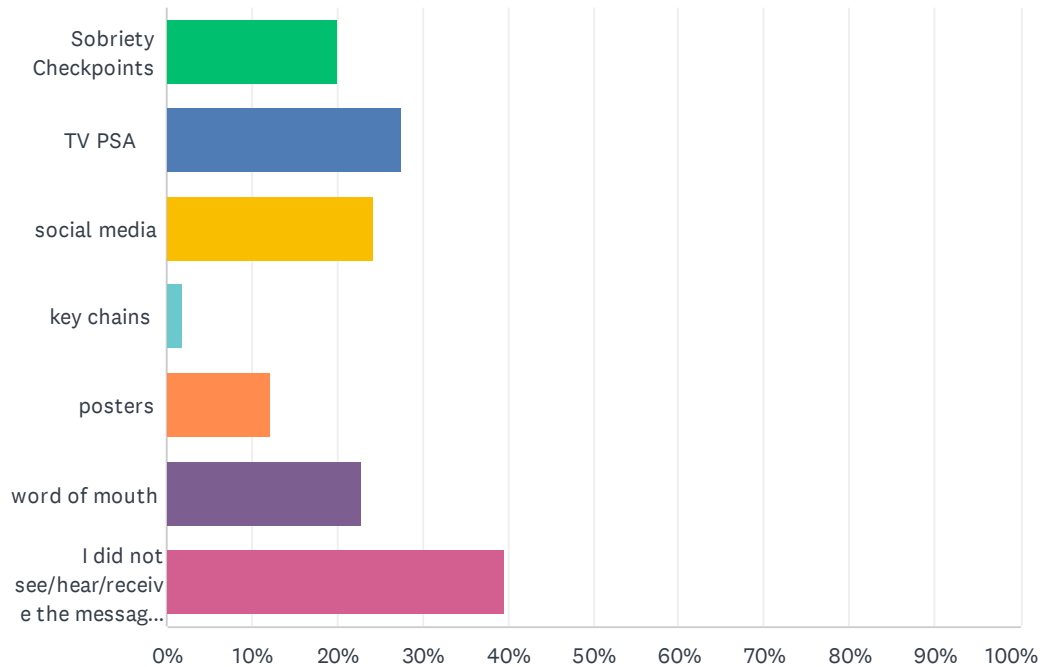

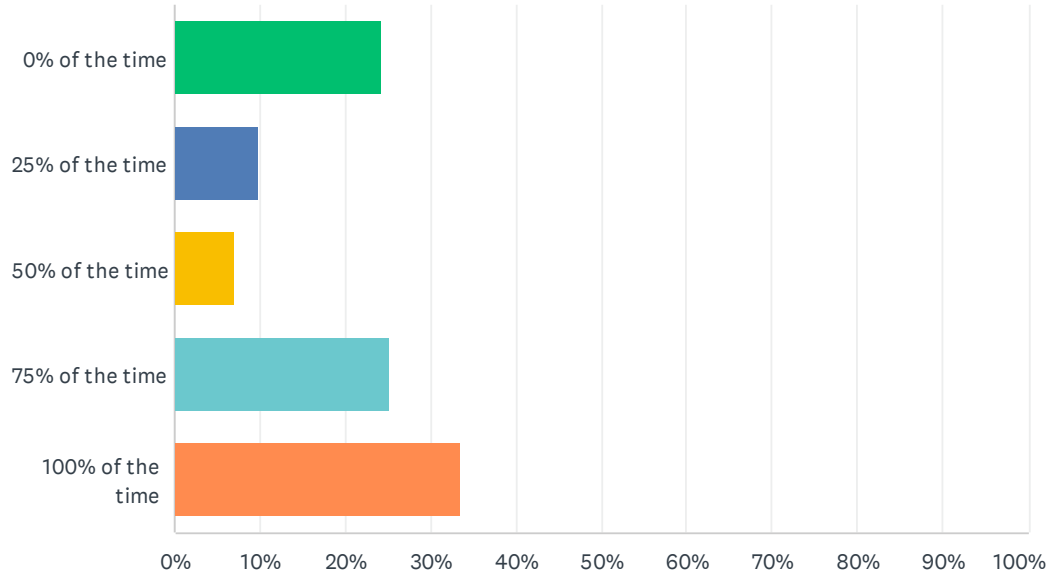

## Q4 When you "party"/ socialize or get together with your friends, how often do you NOT drink alcohol?

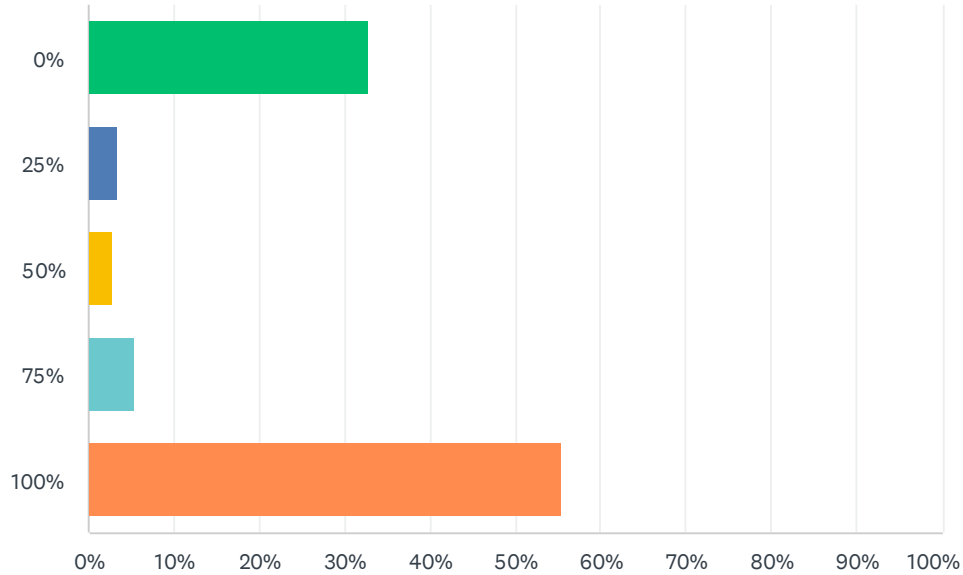

## Q5 During the last year, if you "partied"/"socialized", how often did you use a designated driver?

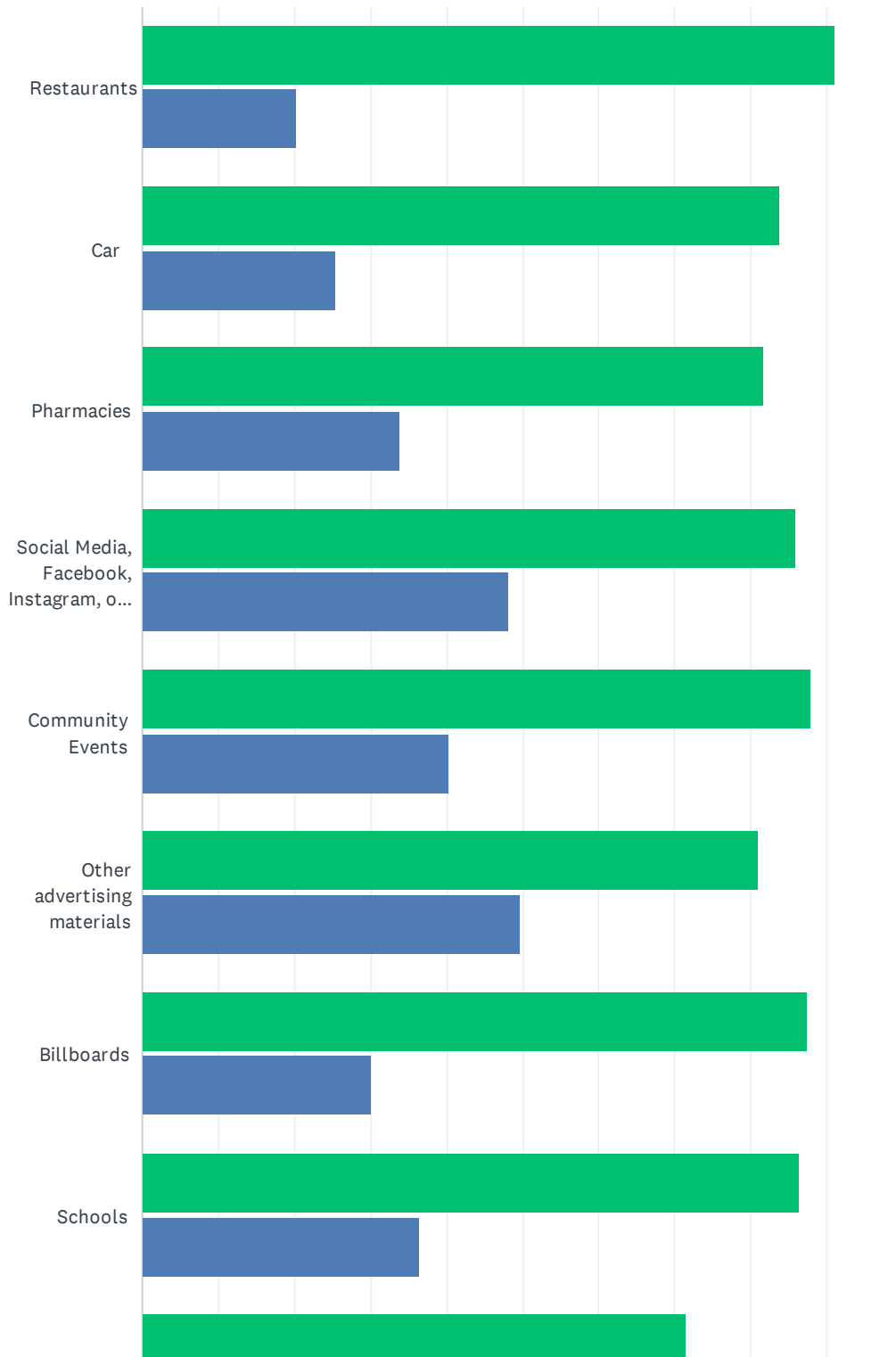

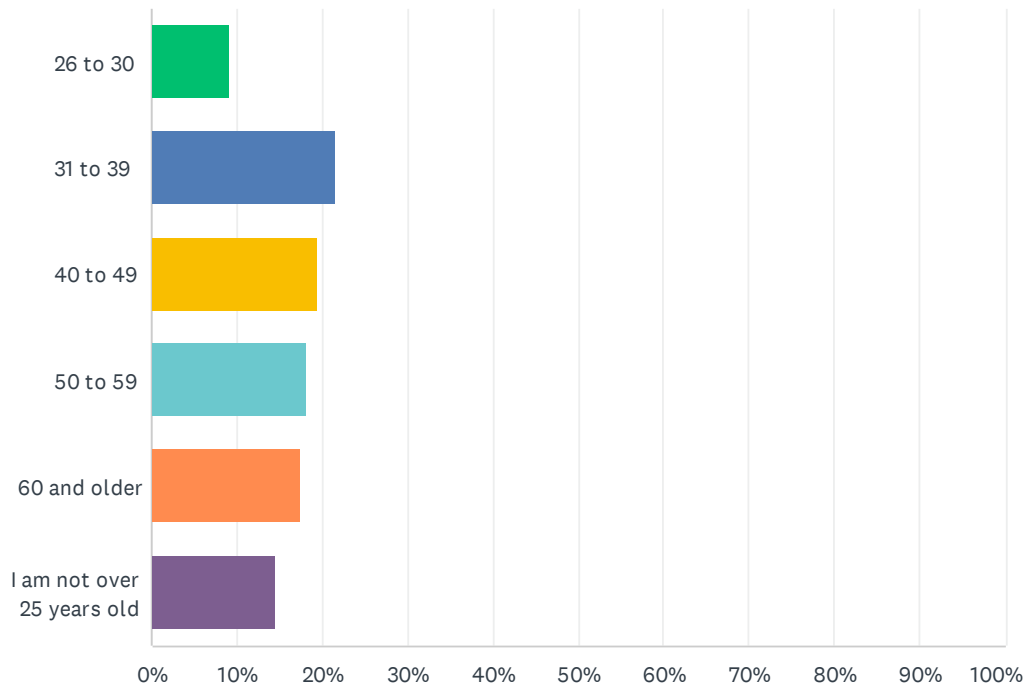

## Q8 If you are over the age of 25, please specify your age group.

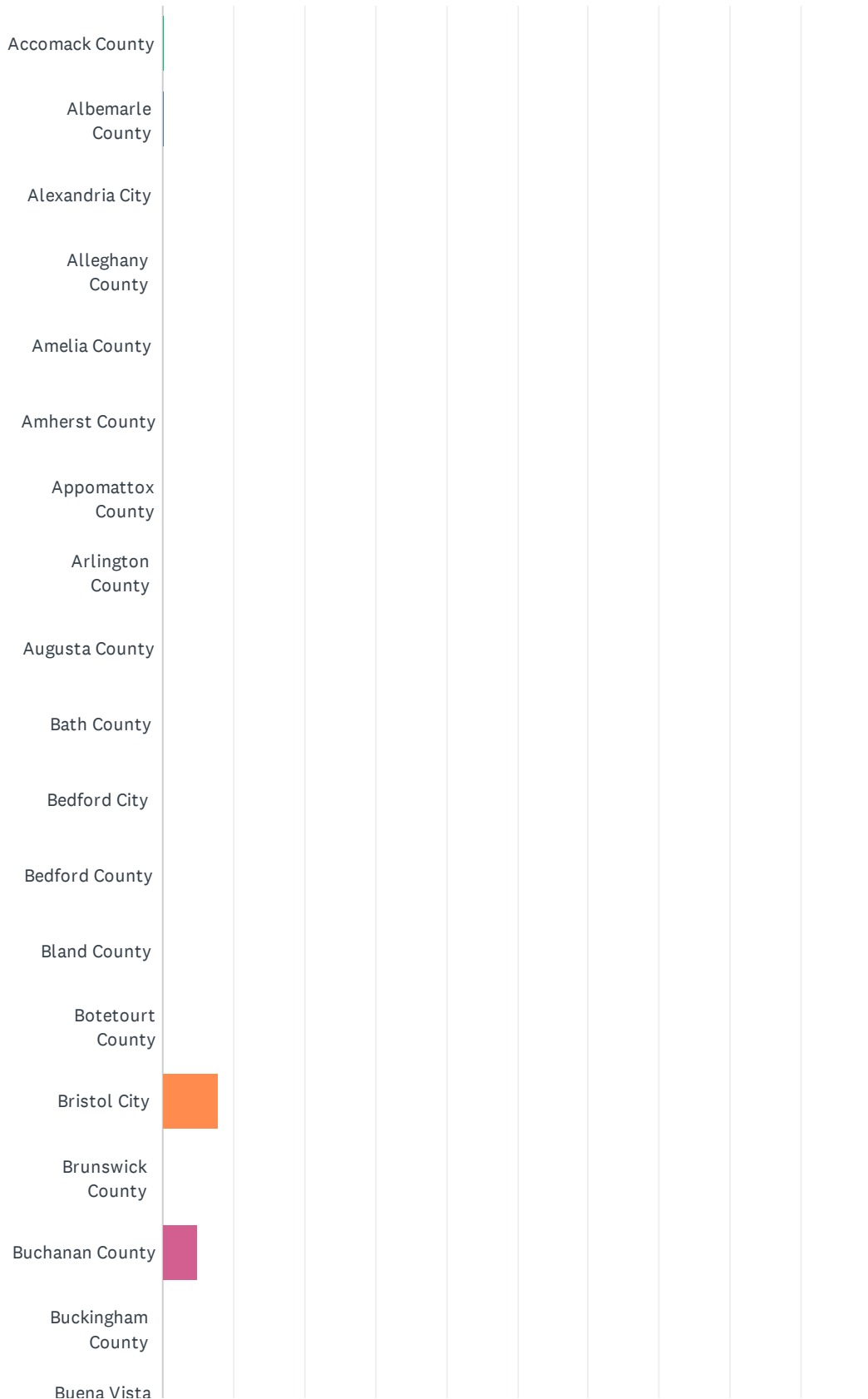

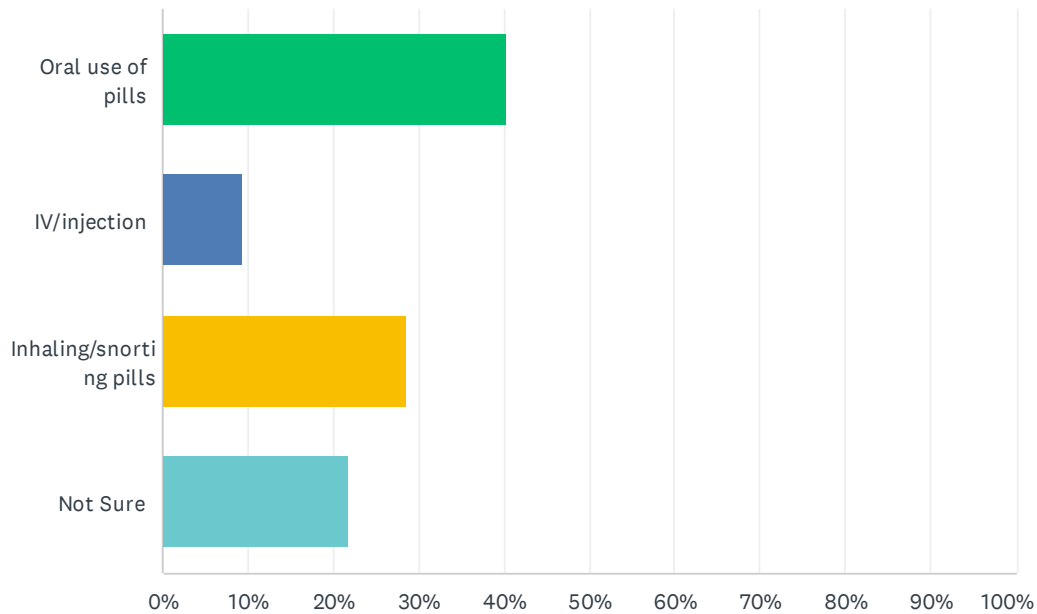

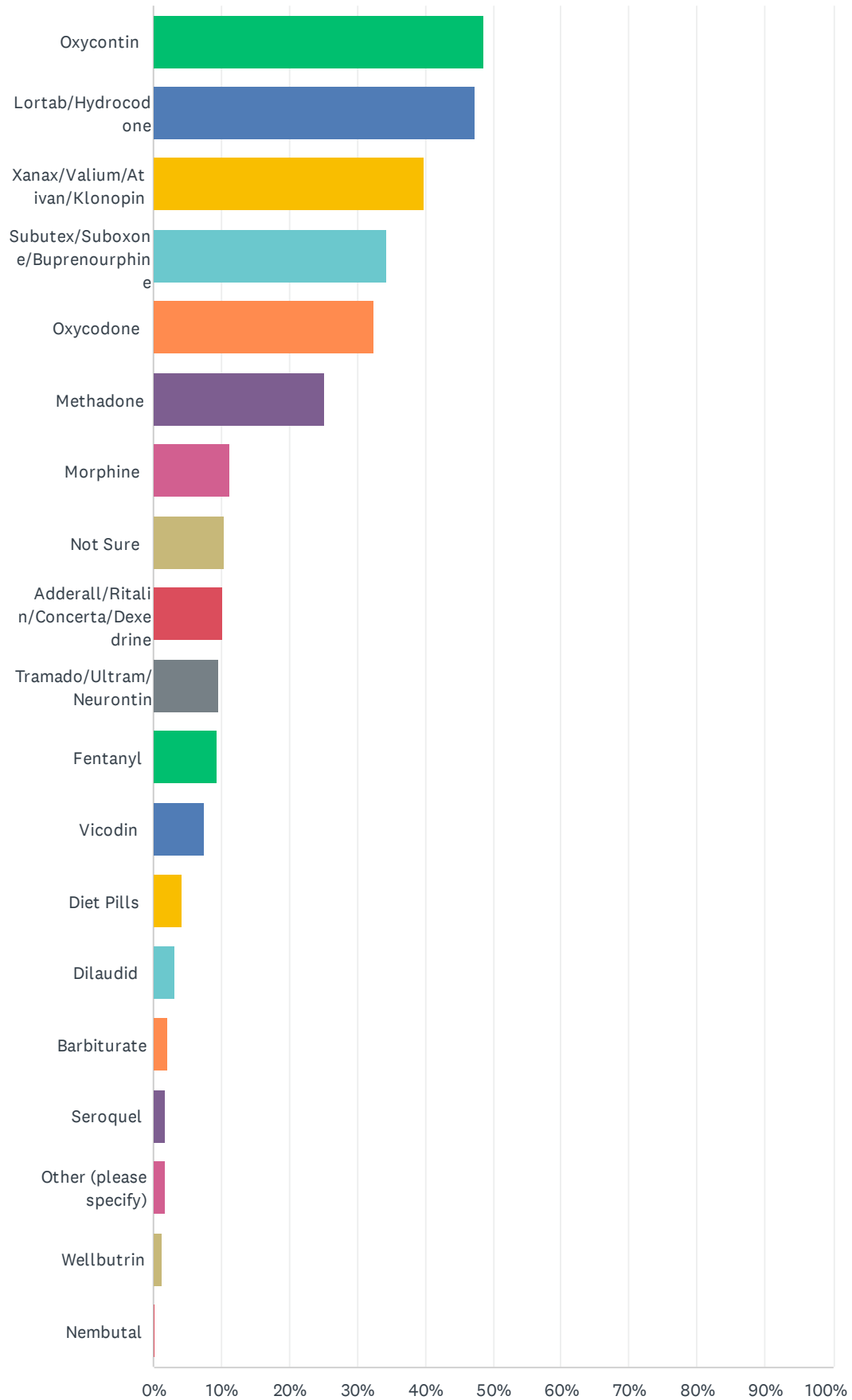

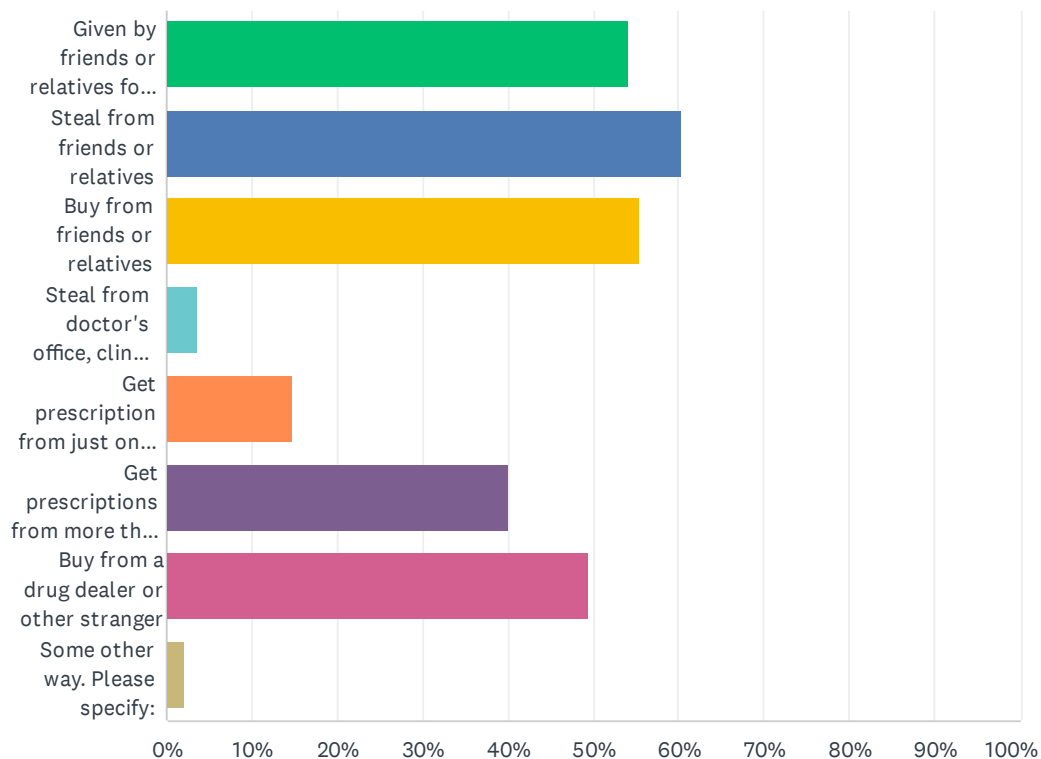

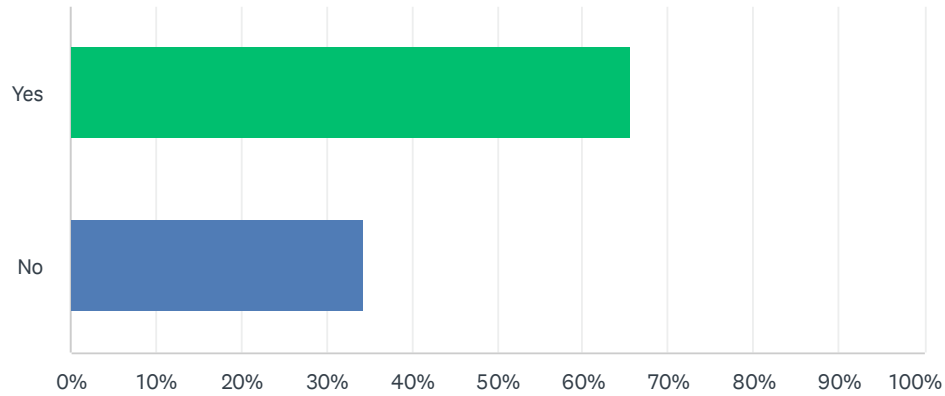

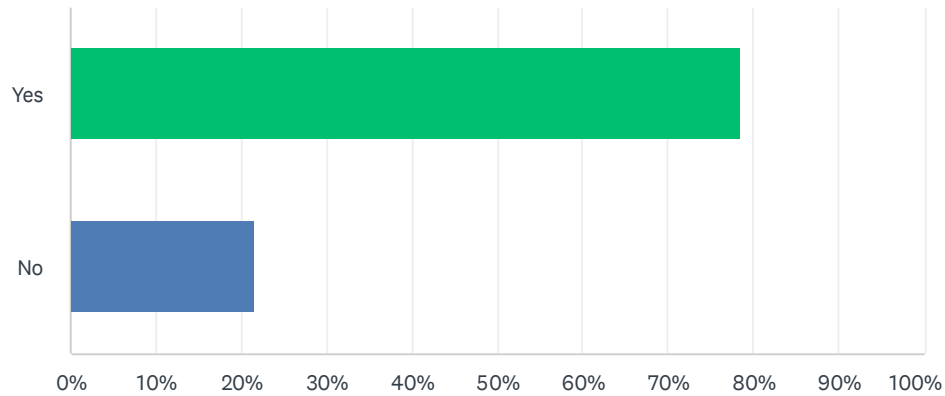

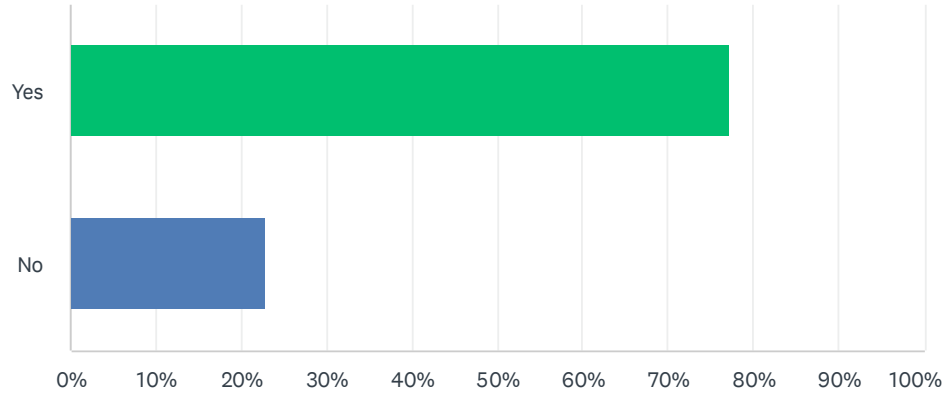

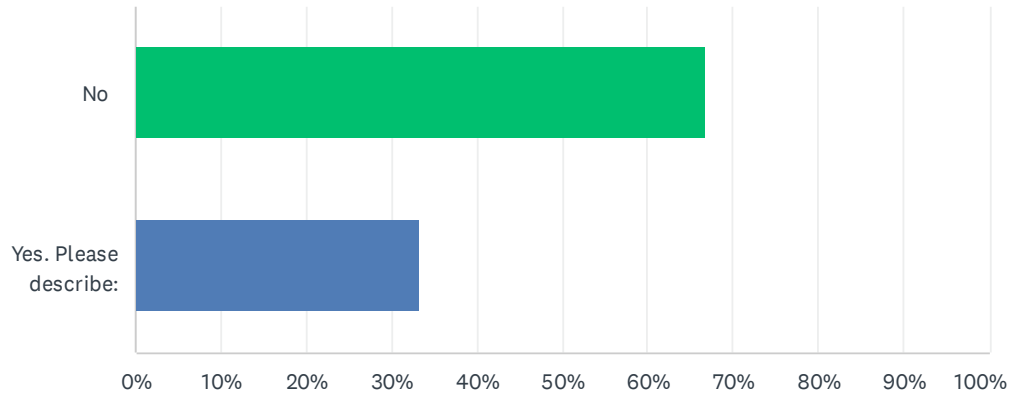

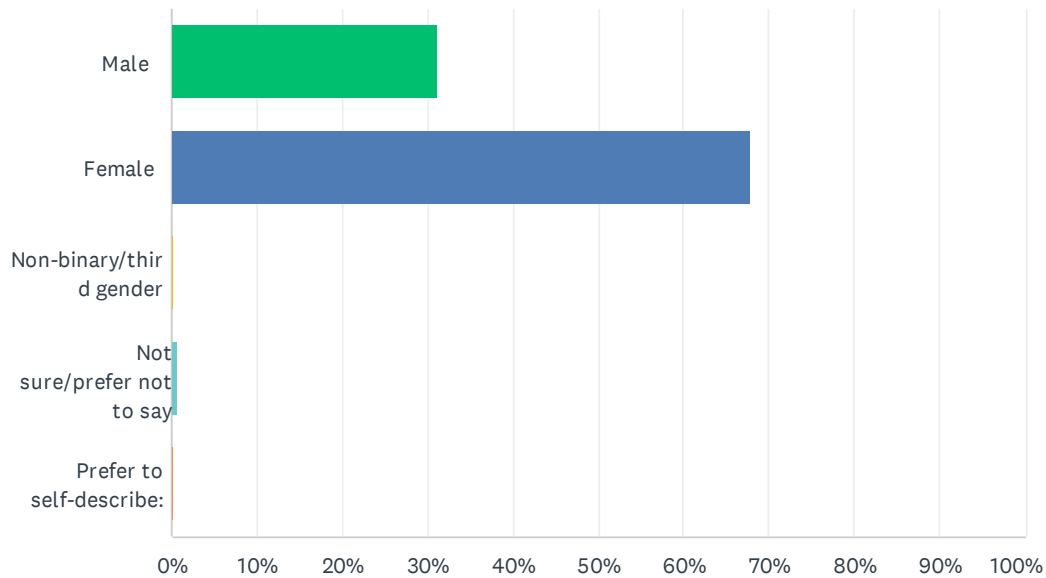

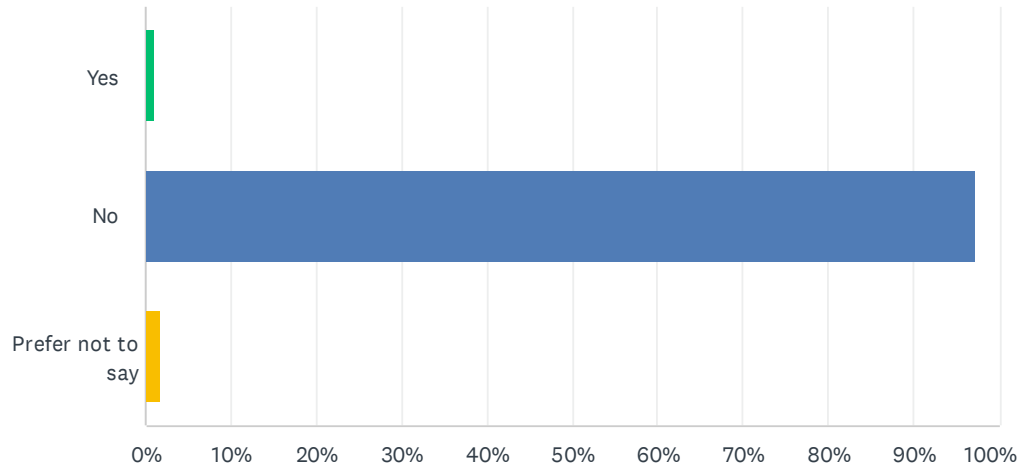

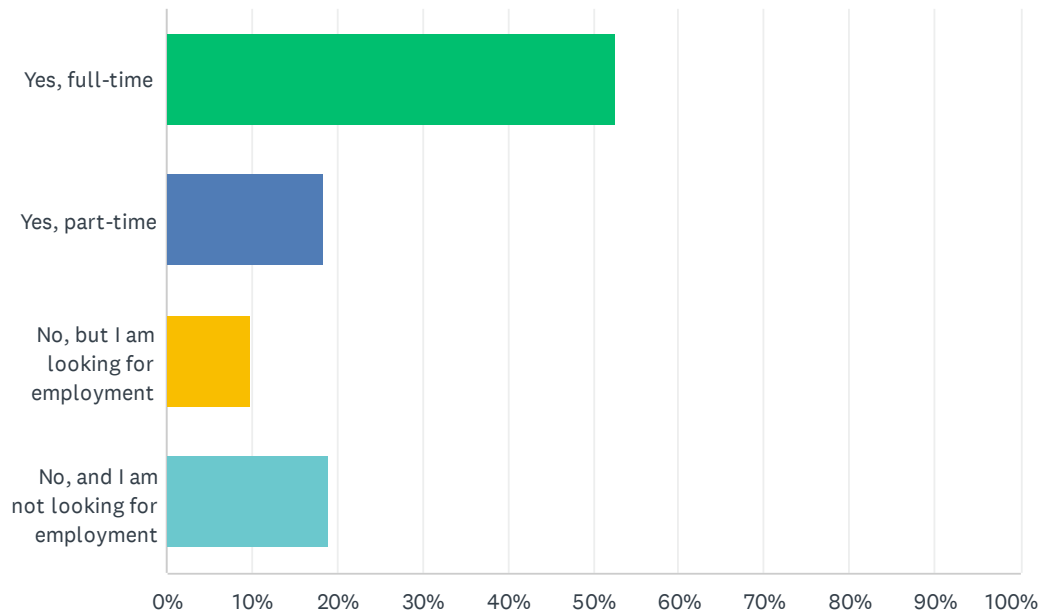

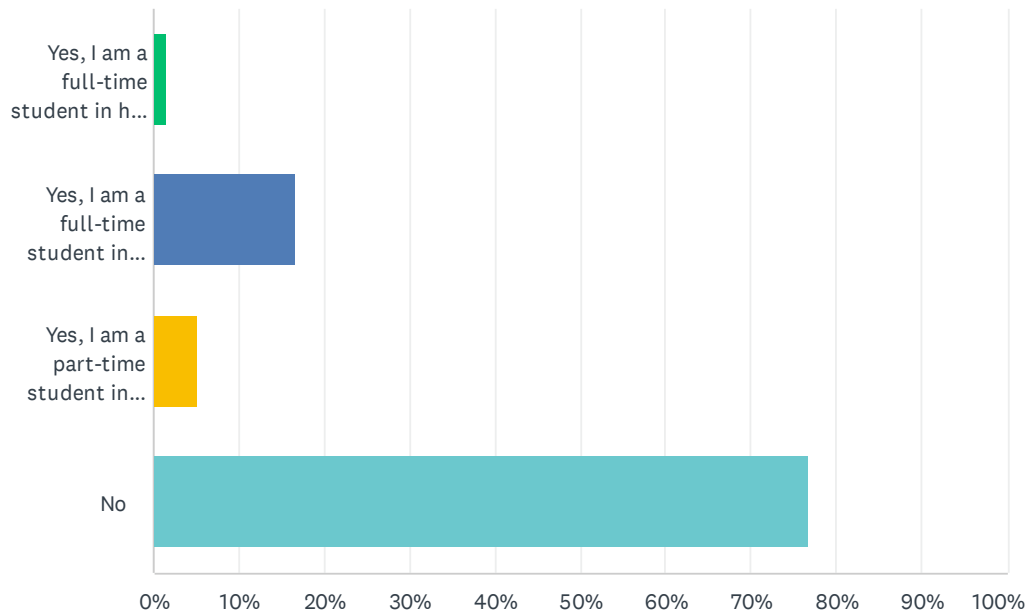

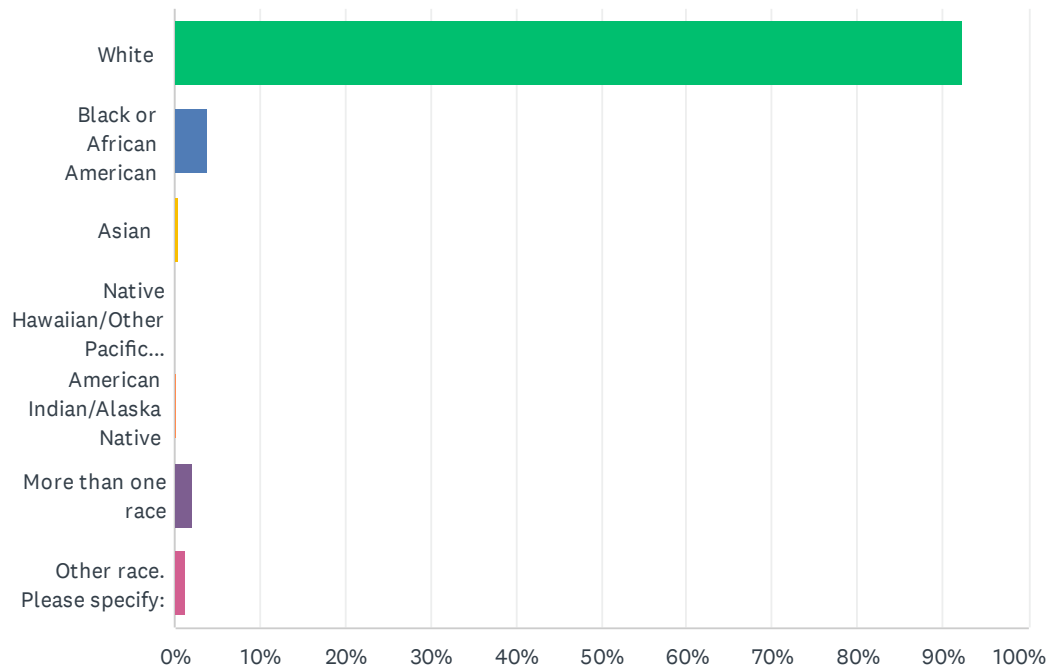

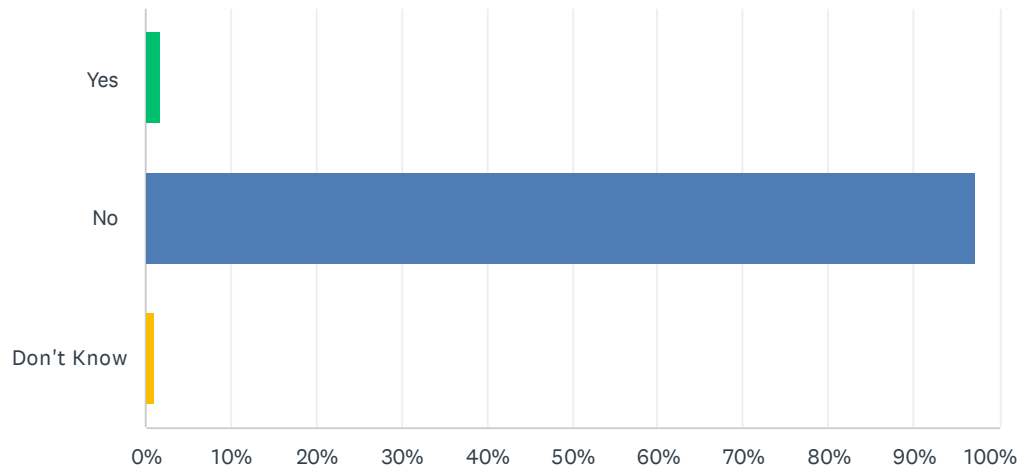

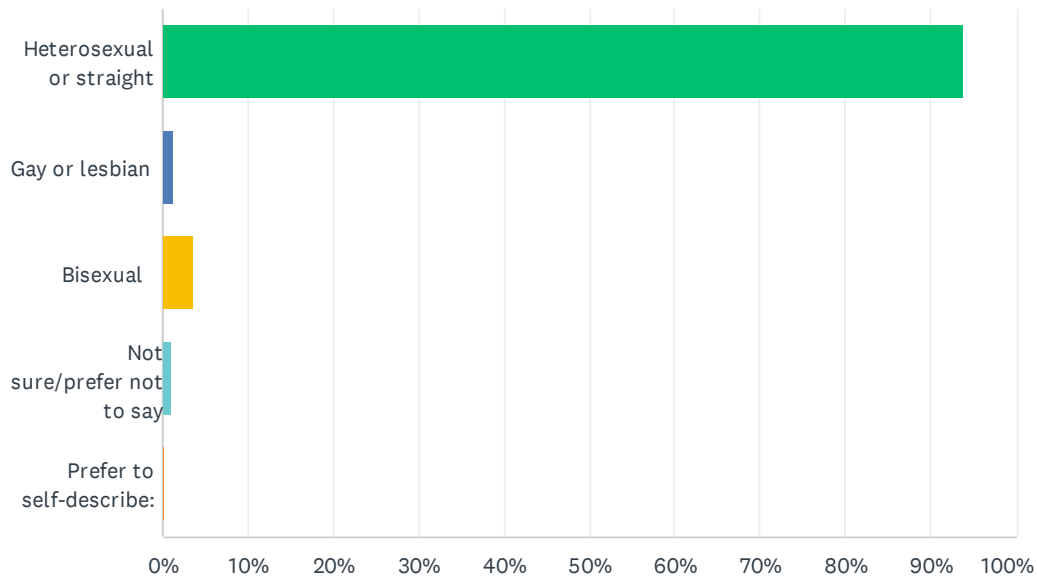

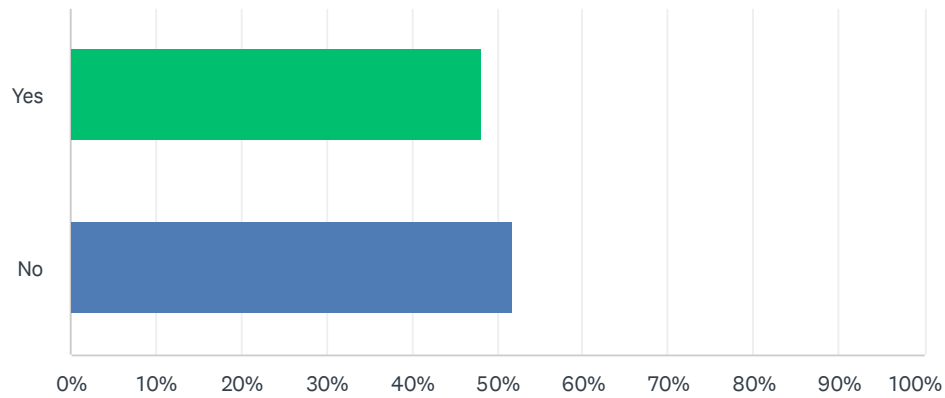

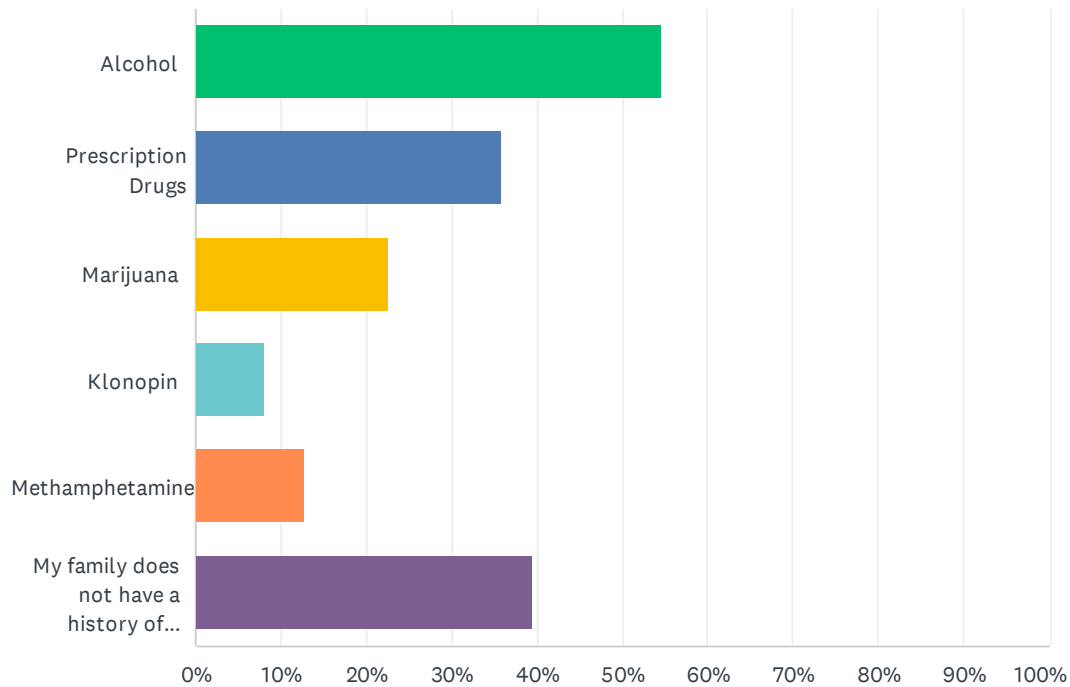

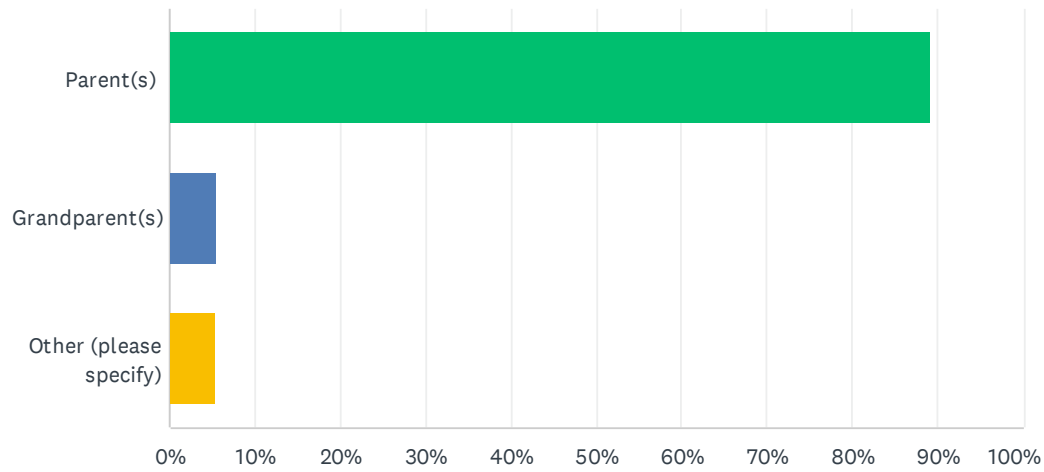
