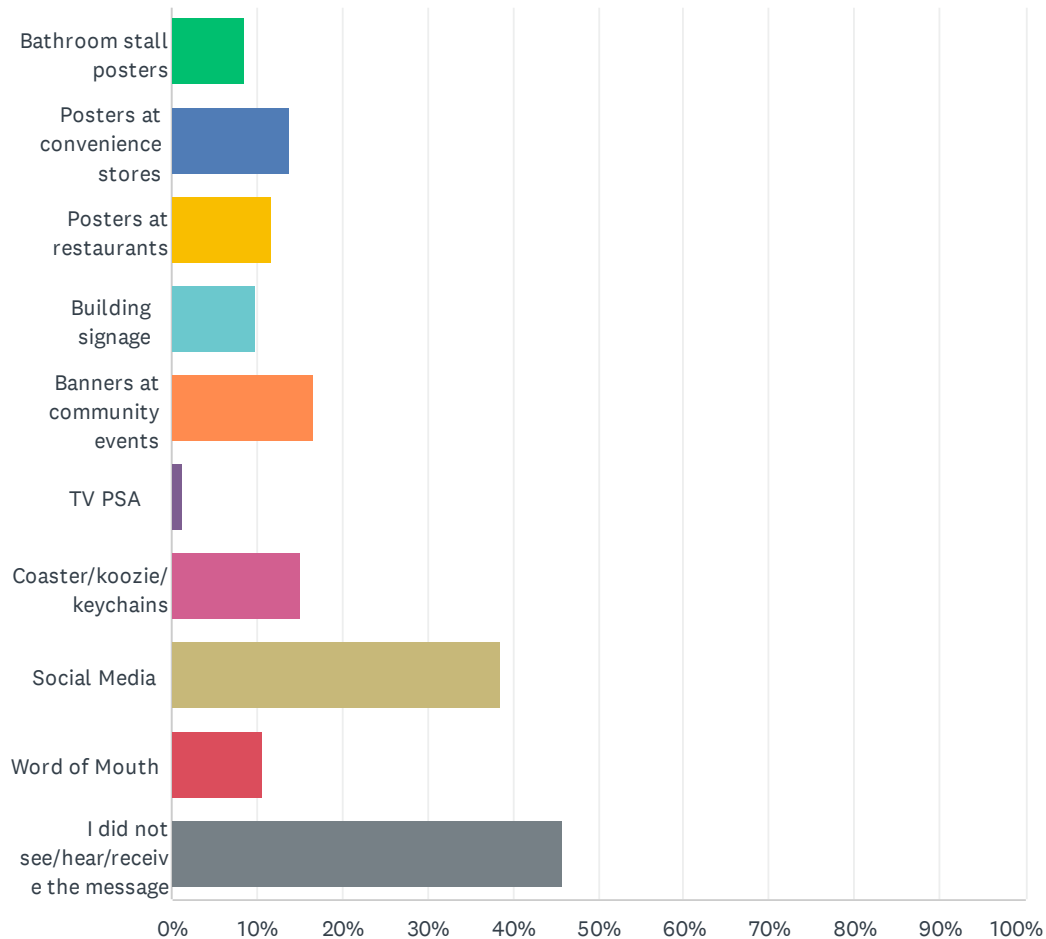

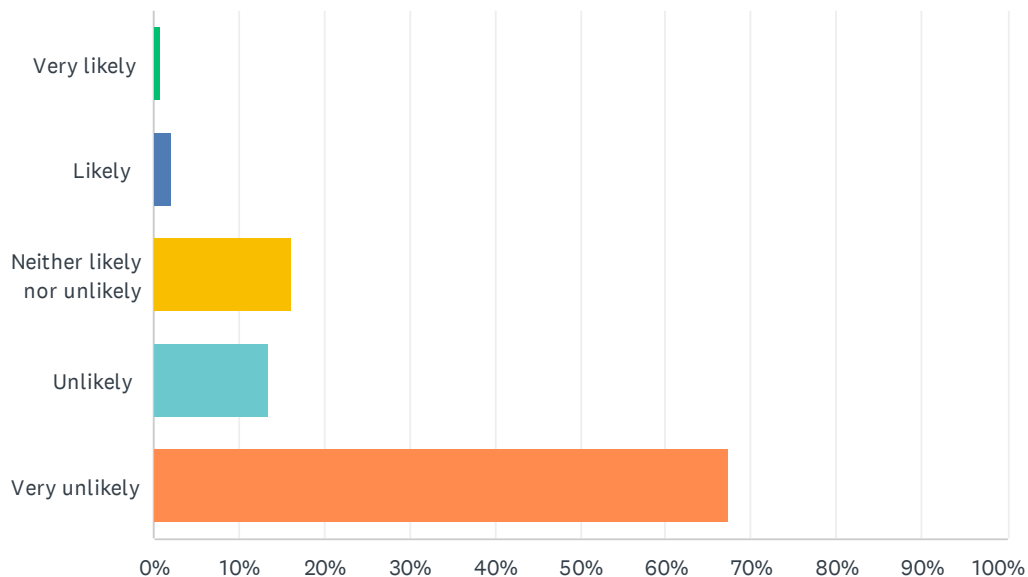

Q2 How likely are you to drink & drive after seeing/hearing/receiving the message "Keep the Party Alive, Don't Drink and Drive?"

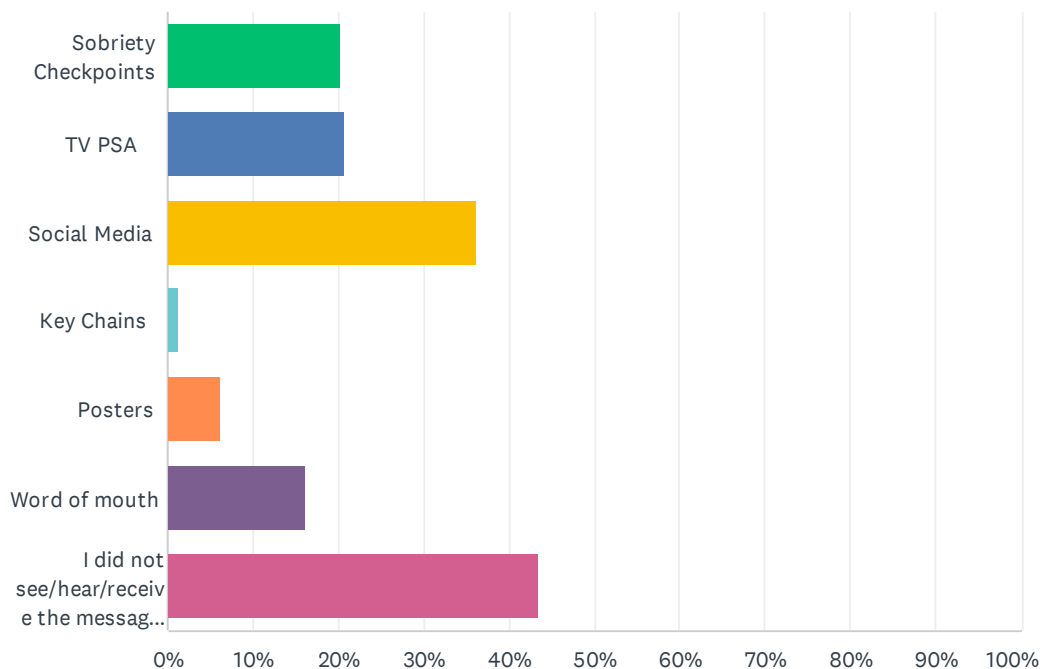

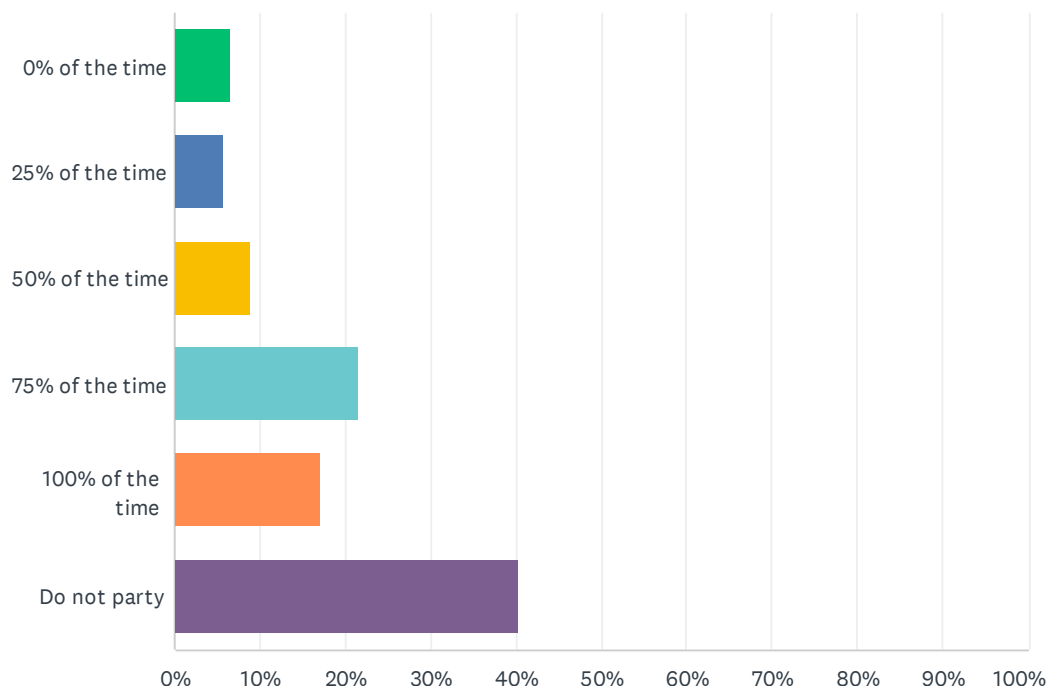

Q4 When you "party"/ socialize or get together with your friends, how often do you NOT drink alcohol

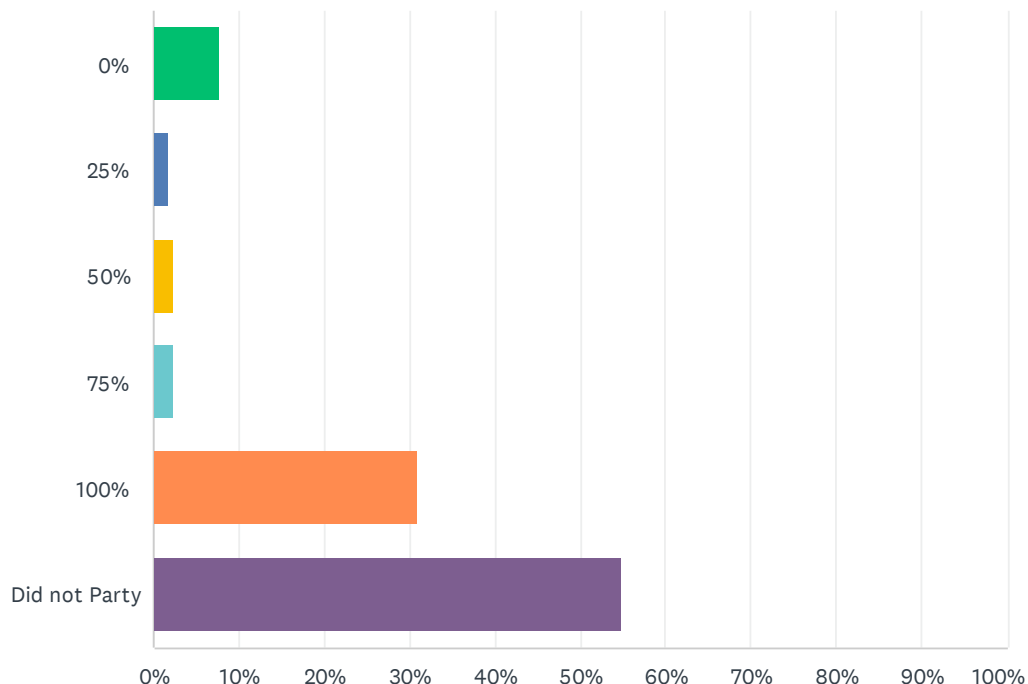

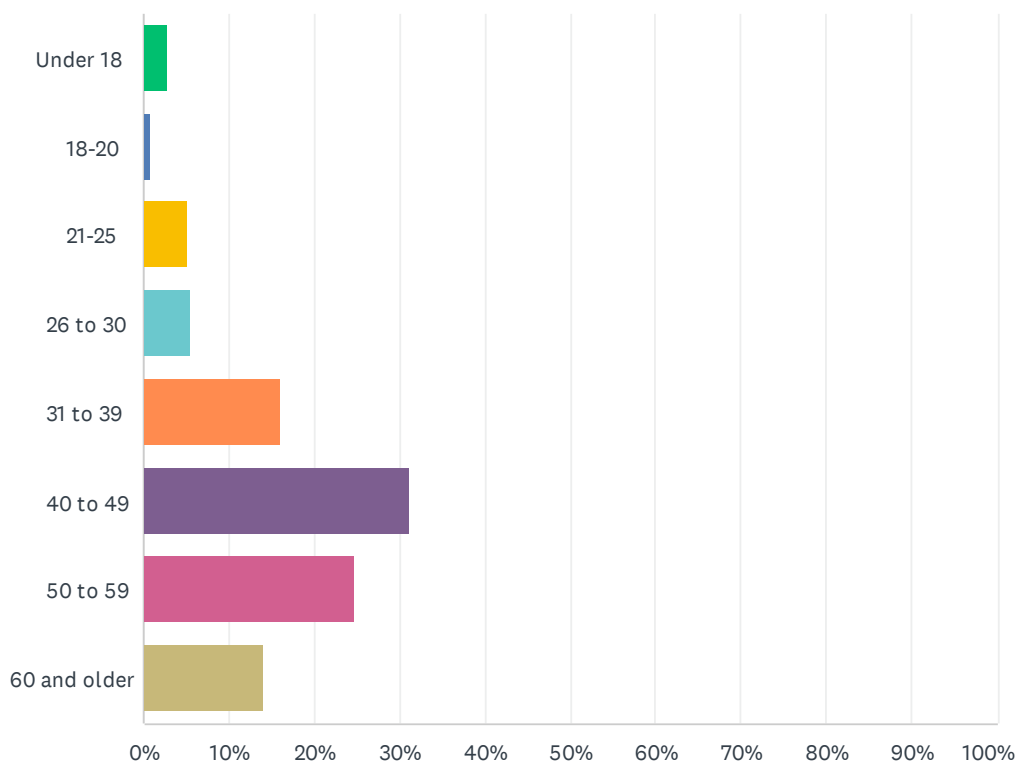

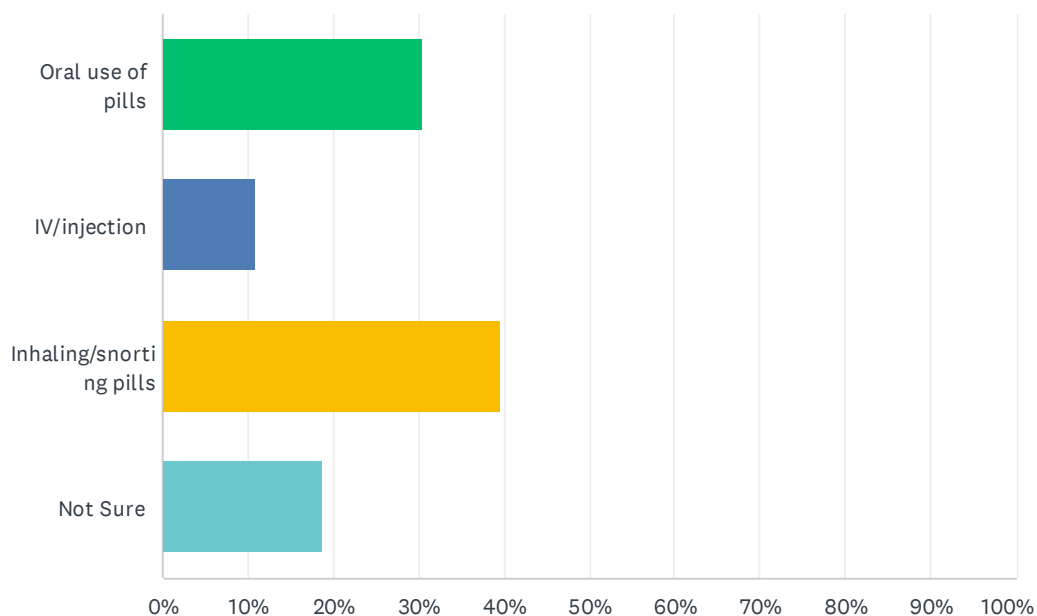

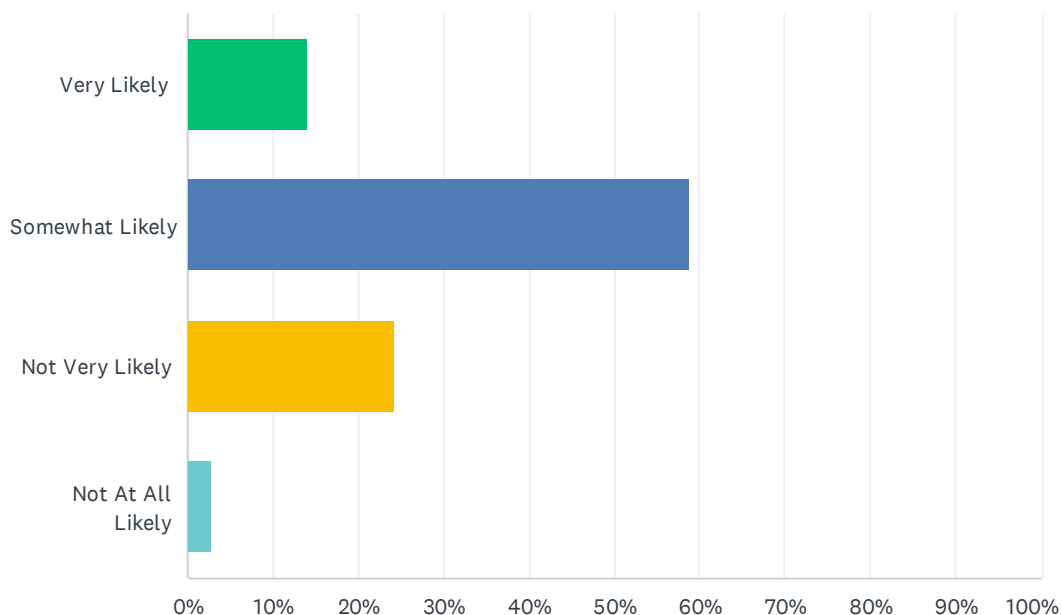

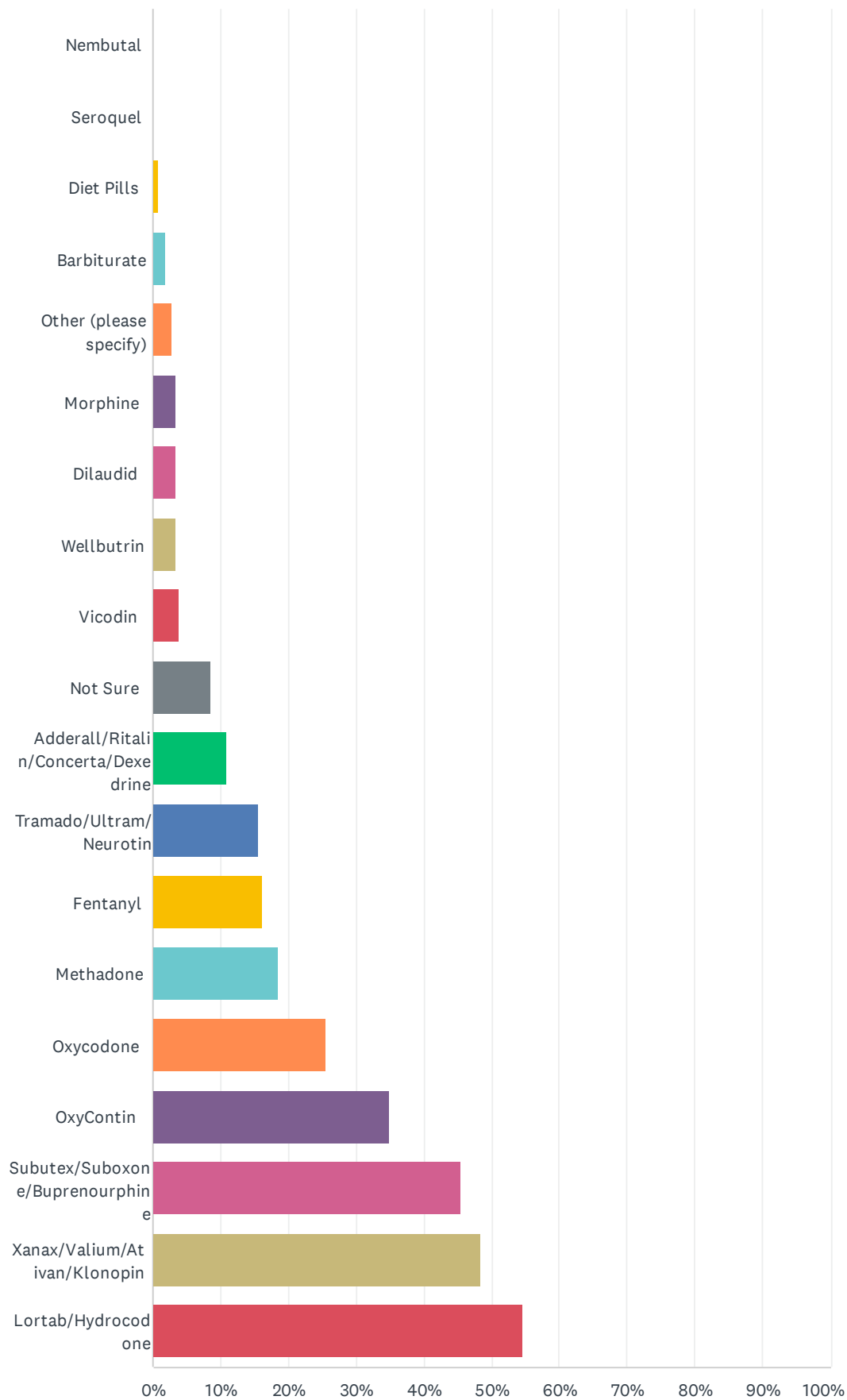

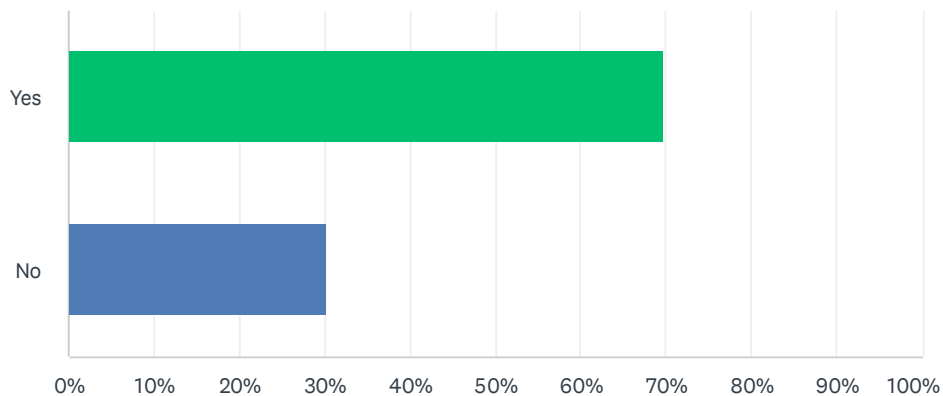

Q20 Within the past 12 months, have you seen or heard any information regarding safe storage of prescription drugs (e.g., medication lock boxes)?

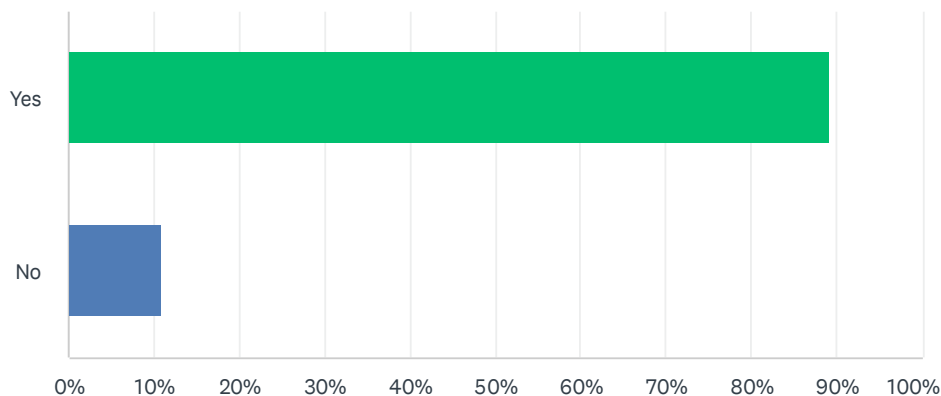

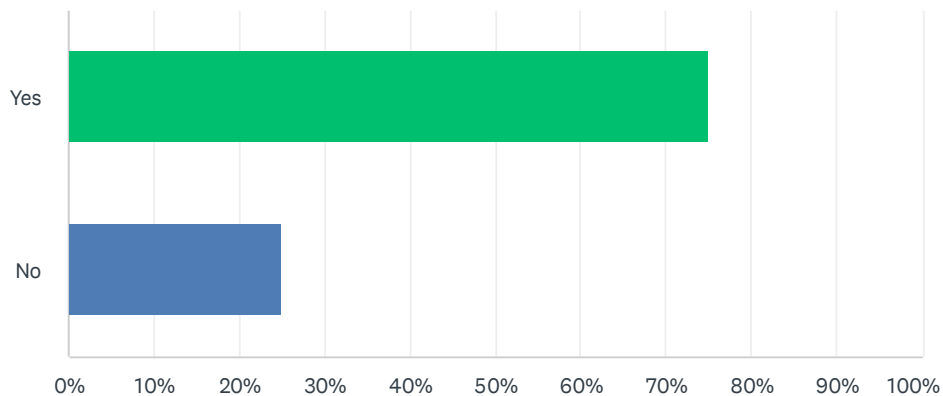

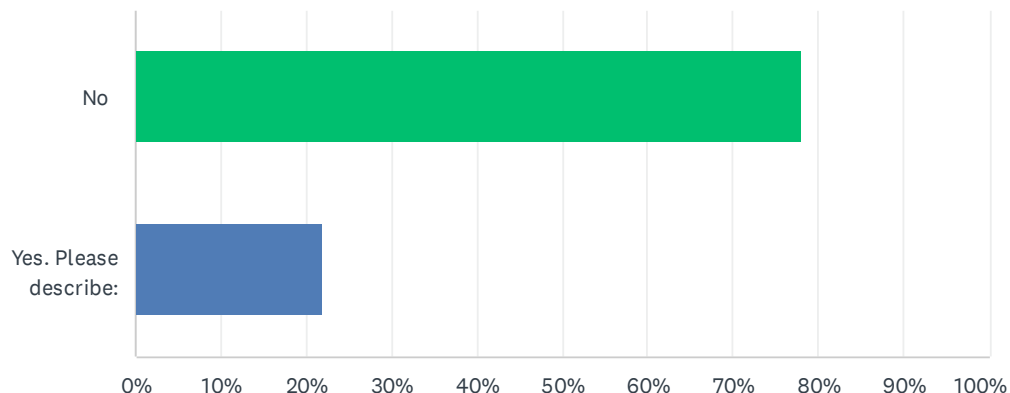

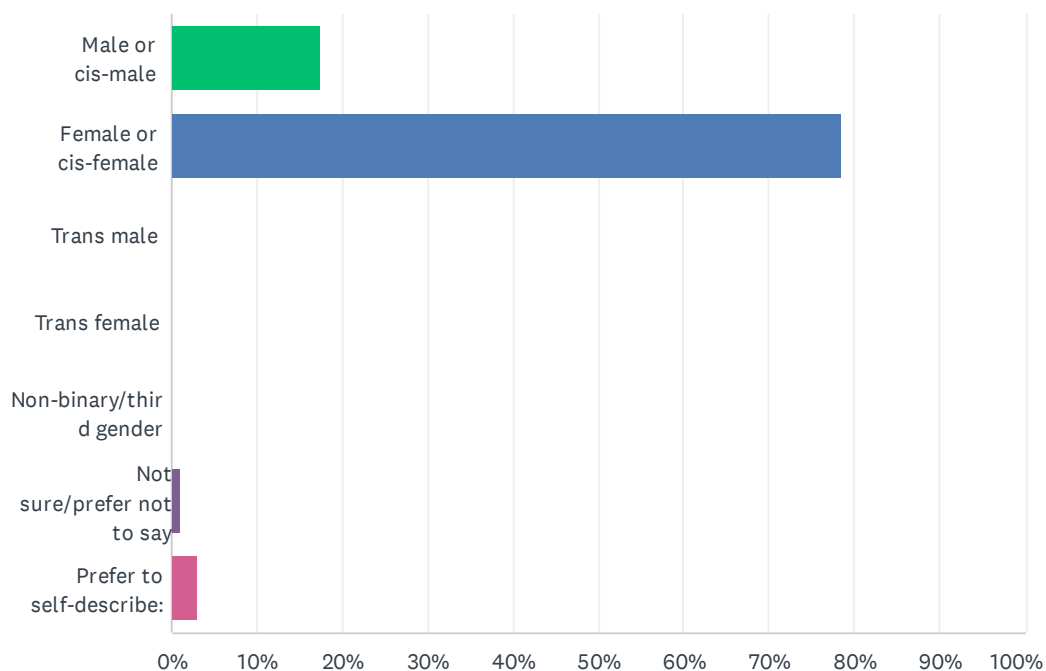

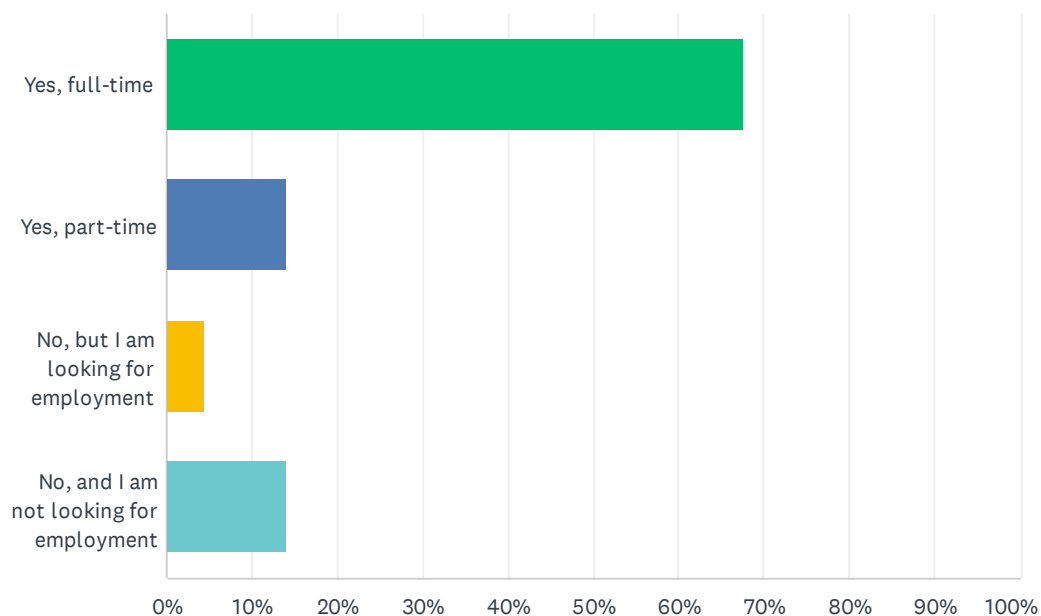

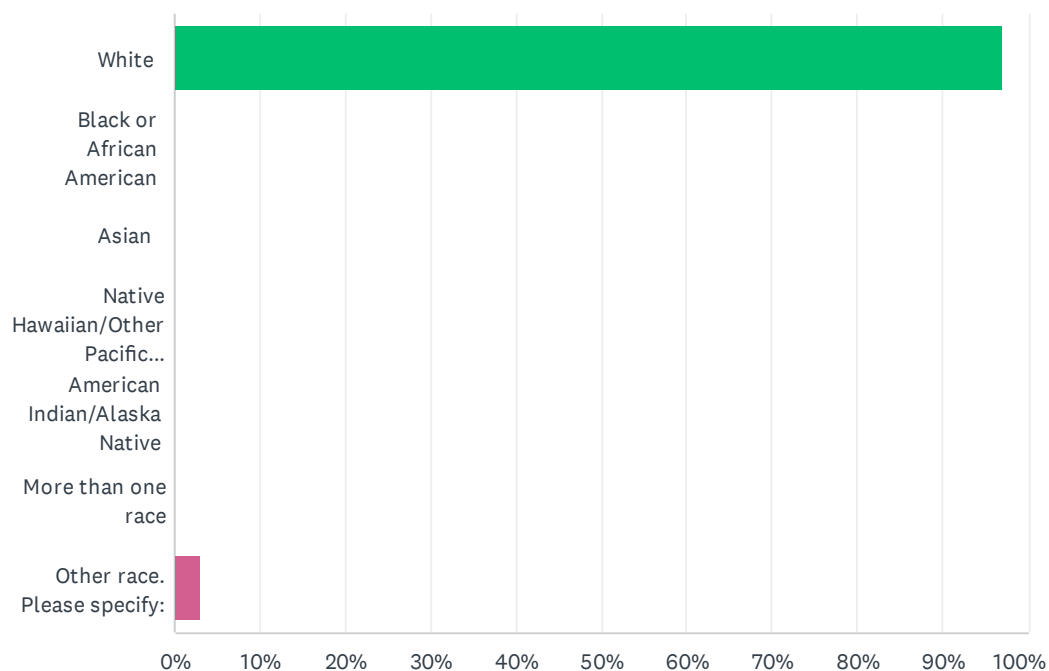

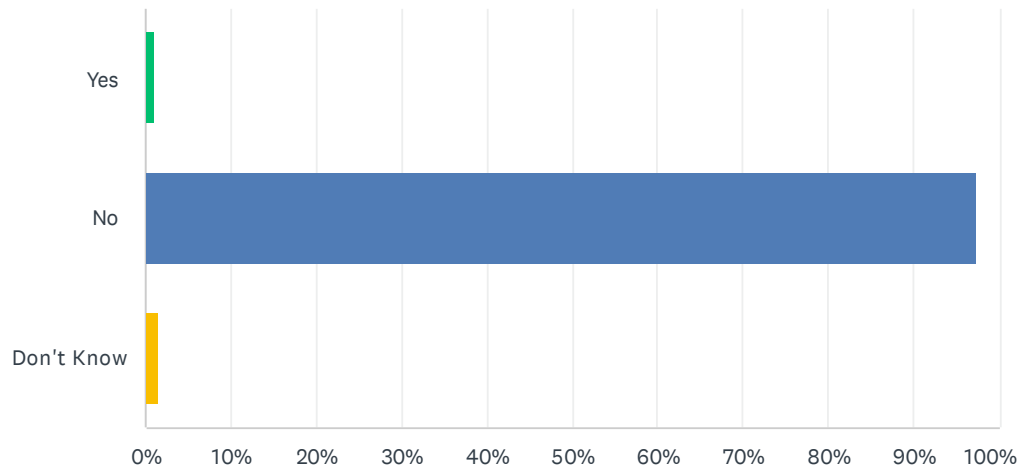

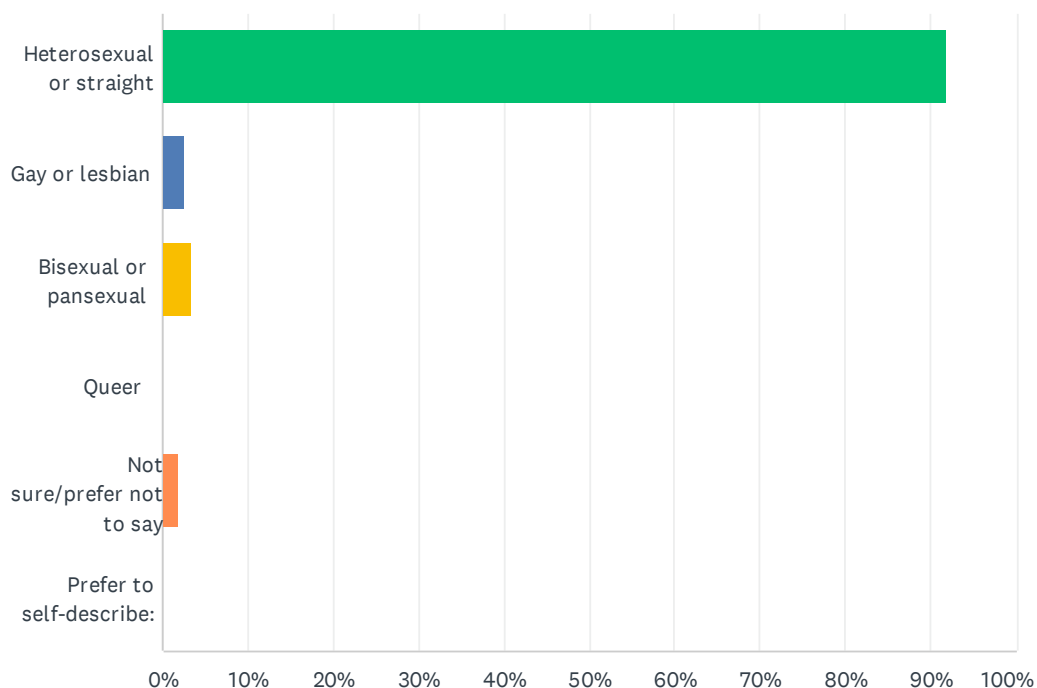

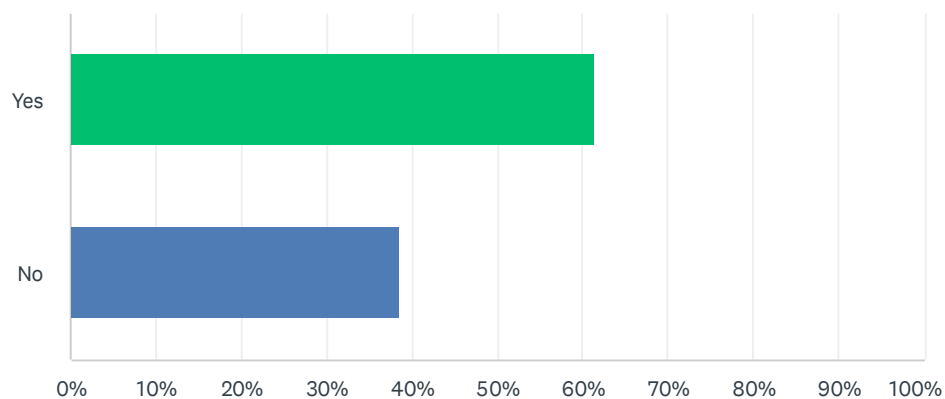
