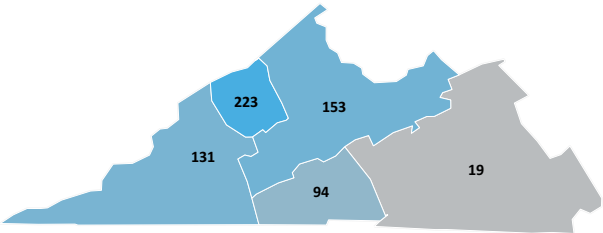

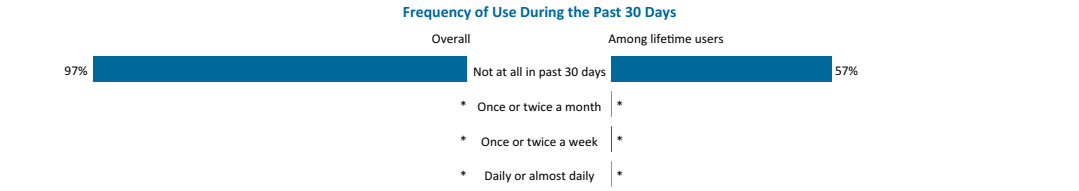

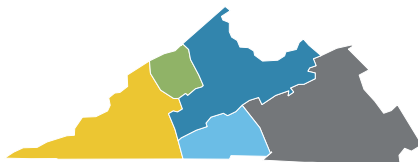

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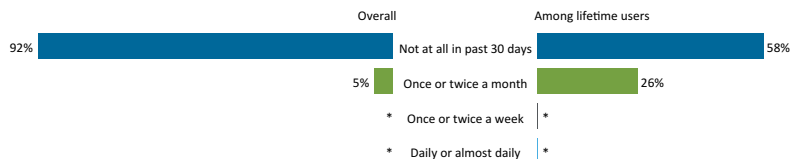

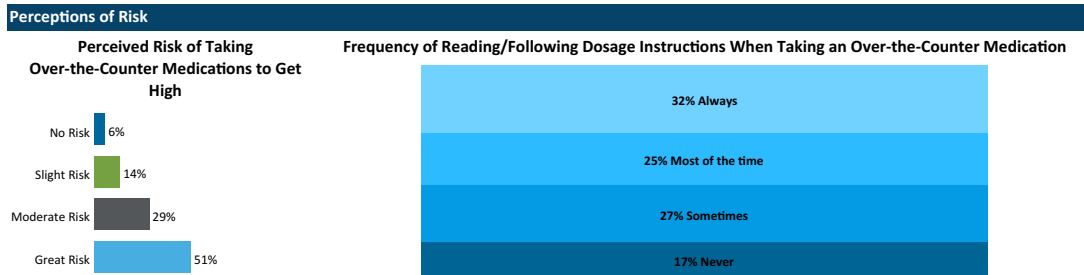
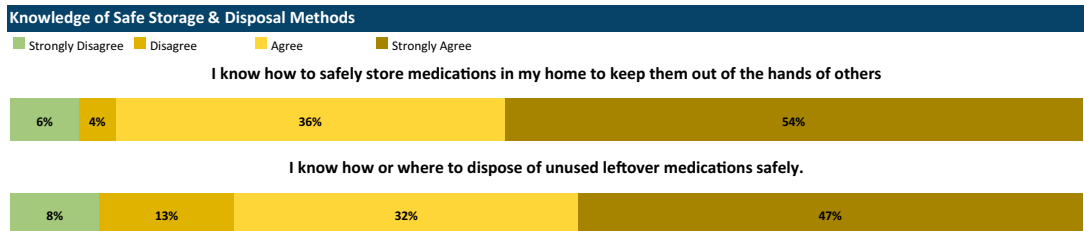
Frequency of Use During the Past 30 Days
